- *Our main target will be:*

The project EUROPA-MEISTER creates the European Master Craftsman's Certificate in Painting.

- *The following objectives shall be achieved in stages:*

1. To draw up a competence matrix at level 6 of the **E**uropean **Q**ualifications **F**ramework (EQF).
2. Establishment of a multilingual competence matrix in Skills bank in database for all project partners.
3. Creation of the basis for a European network of complementary master schools.
4. Development of an e-learning course system for cross-border master craftsman training with test run with selected master students. This test run is then called >Europe Waltz<.
5. *European Meister* certificate awarded and recognized by UNIEP. An audit and control commission will be set up for this purpose. UNIEP will establish and advertise the *Europa Meister* and the *Europe Meister* certificate as a seal of quality in Europe. The *Europe Meister* will serve as a model for other crafts trades.

First and foremost, the project should have a major impact on the participating institutions, target groups and other relevant stakeholders. In addition, indirectly at local, regional, national and European level.
